It is once again time for us to convene for our First District Pastors' Conference. The 36th Annual Pastors' Conference will be hosted by the Hopkinsville College of the Bible, 125 N. Vine Street, Hopkinsville, Kentucky. The conference host is Rev. Dr. M. O. Fort, President of the College. The dates for the conference are Wednesday, March 13 and Thursday, March 14, 2019. Please note that no meals will be served.

It is with great anticipation that we prepare our hearts for a spirit-filled session. Our theme this year is "Adam Where Art Thou?" (Genesis 3:7-22). Our featured speaker will be Rev.
